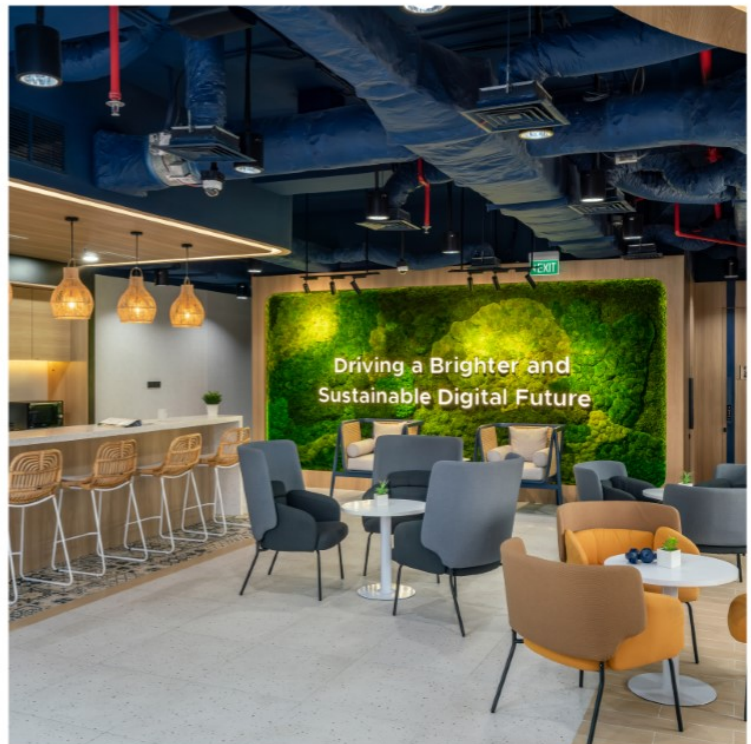

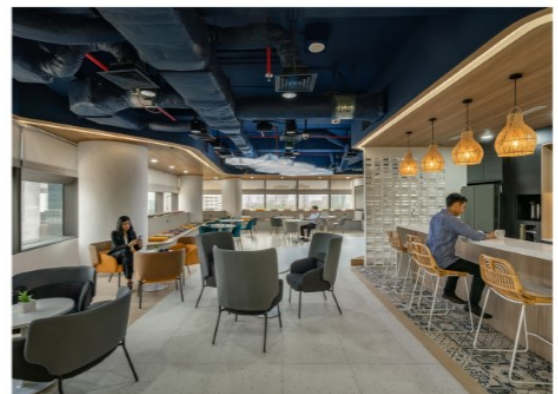
DIGITAL FUTURE OF NUSANTARA

The design creates a modern ambiance that is applied in various material finishes such as different floor material combinations, wall graphics, and bright paint colors to bring a modern and fun working ambiance.

Indonesia is very rich and diverse in culture, yet encompasses more than 300 ethnic groups and cultures, with dozens of languages, and different social and cultural backgrounds.



With this rich culture, the Designer applies patterns, shapes, and cultural elements in office design. There are several patterns of traditional Indonesian fabrics applied such as Tenun Tanimbar from Maluku, Ulos from West Sumatra and Songket Pucuk Rebuang from Palembang.

The selection of the Javanese antique chair, batik patterned fabric to cushion covers, roster as a room partition, rattan chairs and rattan lamp also applied to add a more local and traditional feel.

The interior design of the Lembaga Penjamin Simpanan (LPS) office incorporates Nusantara architectural elements with a modern twist, blending traditional architectural details with contemporary aesthetics, materials, and functionality.

This results in a unique and innovative space that supports national economic sustainability and inspires user creativity.

The use of marble and a touch of gold in some ornaments are applied to add a sense of elegance, while the use of wood colors gives a warm and welcoming impression, creating a balance between luxury and warmth in the interior design.

With the diversity and richness of Indonesian culture, the Designer applies it into patterns, shapes and elements in the office design, creating a space that reflects the uniqueness of local culture.



There are several patterns of traditional Indonesian fabrics applied such as Songket Sirih Junjung fabric motif from Sumatra, Kalabbaring motif from Sulawesi, Batik Parang motif from Central Java, Hoko Asmat carving motif from Papua, and Kenyalang Dayak motif from Kalimantan.

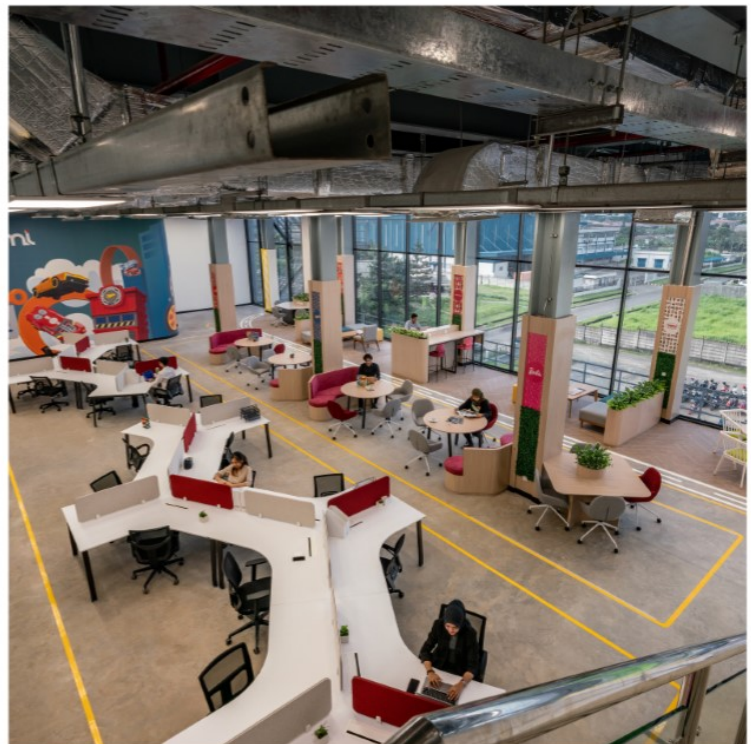
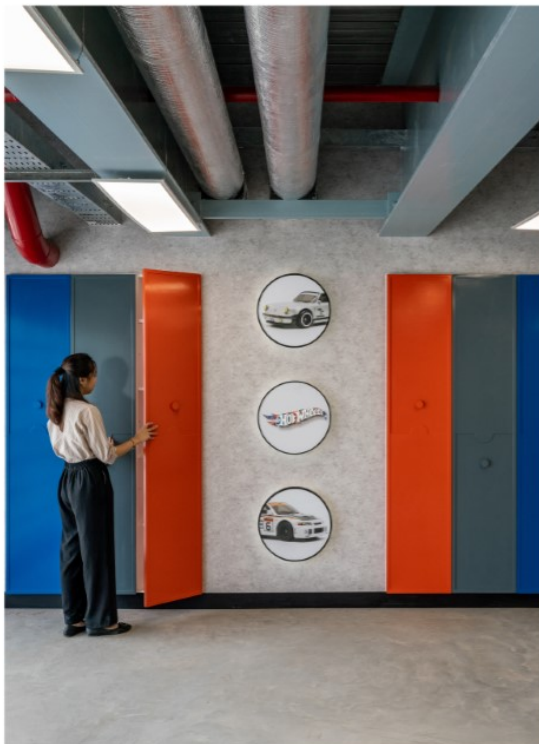
At Lembaga Penjamin Simpanan (LPS) office, there are also decorative elements such as Javanese antique lamps, Papuan decorations, and Dayak shields that serve as wall lights.

To add a local and traditional feel, the Discussion Area is designed to resemble a Pendopo, a traditional Indonesian architectural element commonly used for gatherings, ceremonies, or social activities.

The industrial elements are applied by exposed bricks, cement exposed, open ceiling, spotlights, hanging lamps, etc. As for the fun theme, Designers applied colors from Mattel's toy products such as from Barbie, Uno and also Hot Wheels tracks applied as decoration.

In Mattel's office, some of the Rooms are named after their famous product brands. Such as "The Barbie Room", "Hot Wheels Room" and "Uno Room", where each room is decorated according to the product name.



The Staff Area is designed with an open space concept that is applied to support large collaboration and boost productivity amongst the employees. Inspired by one of Mattel's products, Hot Wheels, Designer painted the Hot Wheels "Track" on the floor surrounding the office, giving the impression of fun and playful.

Employees can take a short break or do fun activities at the Breakout Space, which features games such as Uno and Uno Stacko on each table and plenty of snacks available.
