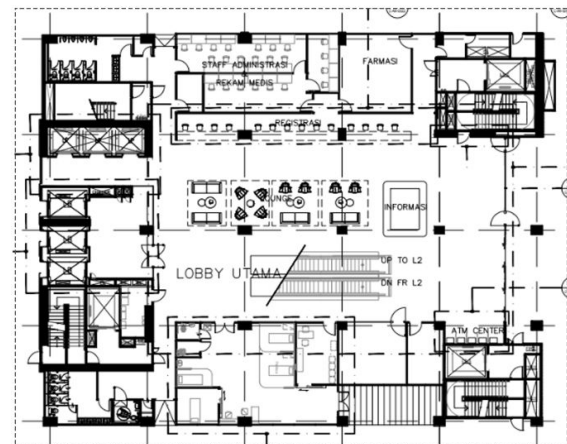

The design concept has a significant impact on how patients perceive and feel about the atmosphere in a hospital. One of the primary functions of hospital interior design is to make patients feel safe and calm. Throughout the design planning process, changes in the interior ambience and material adjustments continue to evolve. Simplifications of the initial concept occur in certain areas. The desired ambience is modern and simple, featuring clean linear lines and warm colors that harmonize with natural materials.

One way to enhance the experience for patients and their families is by reducing anxiety. The first impression is the most important. Arrival spaces, such as the lobby, consider the needs of visitors, helping patients and their families feel welcomed and providing clear navigation. There are information zones and counters equipped with digital signage to assist visitors and patients in finding information easily.



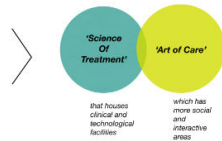

The modern and simple concept is applied to the floor and ceiling patterns, emphasized by the presence of linear lighting. The dominant color is green, serving as an accent with a calming tone. Accent colors used include light gray and cream, applied to wall treatments and furniture. The clinic area, designed with a see-through concept, directly faces the exterior of the building, allowing natural light to create a warmer and more relaxed atmosphere during consultations.
