Jakarta Intercultural School - High school Library | is an example of modern design that prioritizes collaboration and interaction. Inspired by the "honeycomb" shape, the building reflects order and cooperation, perfect for a dynamic learning environment.

With an area of 2100 m² and two floors, this library is a center for contemporary culture. The building's accessibility is enhanced by bridges connecting it to other buildings nearby, while skylights not only provide natural lighting but also create a warm, open atmosphere in the entry area.

The first floor is dedicated to public facilities, including an auditorium, classrooms, and cafe, creating a welcoming atmosphere for studying and socializing. Meanwhile, the second floor is focused on the library, providing various types of study areas designed to meet students' needs, encouraging exploration and active learning.



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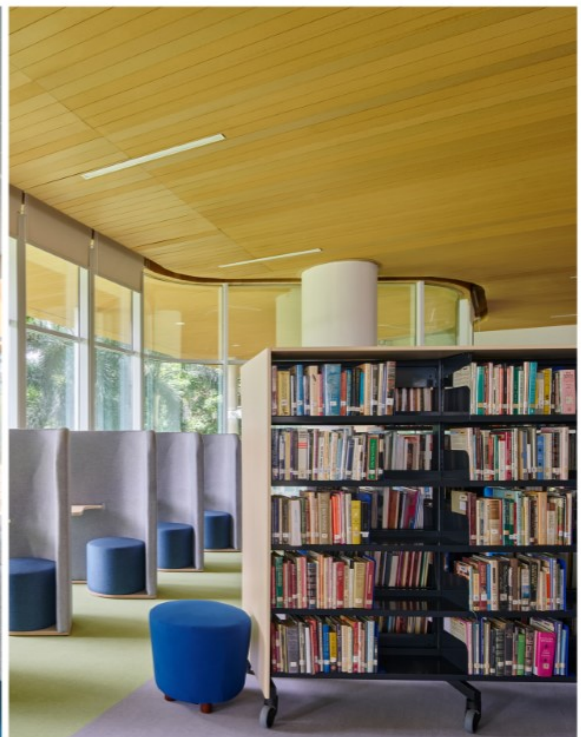
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Learning activities are grouped into three types:

1. Social : This area is designed for casual interactions and group discussions. Bright accent colors are used to create a warm and inviting atmosphere.
2. Collaborative : This space supports collaboration between students on projects or presentations. The use of more neutral colors serves as a visual boundary that encourages collaboration while still providing space for focus.
3. Individual / Focus : This area is designed for personal concentration and deep learning. Calmer accent colors help create an atmosphere conducive to focus.

With this approach, the library not only functions as a place to store books, but also as a dynamic space that adapts to various student learning styles.



The concept of architectural and interior forms that combine to provide a continuous feel. The choice of a natural color scheme on the building facade and up to the interior ceiling creates a calm atmosphere in the library.

The neutral color on the shelves aims to highlight the book collections. The total book capacity that can be accommodated is approximately 12,000 collections. The use of acoustic materials on floors, ceilings and furniture can reduce noise and provide concentration while studying.
