



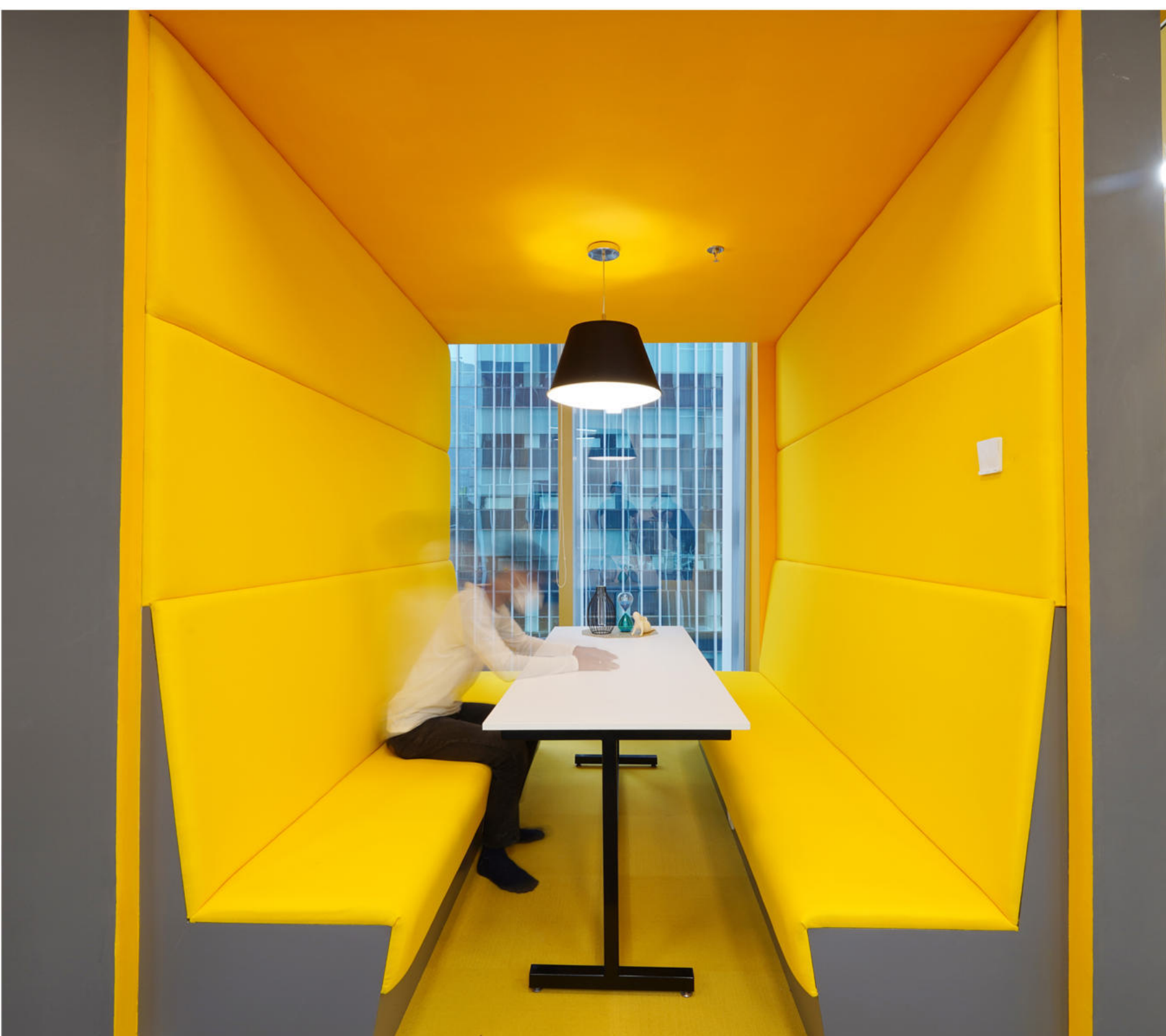

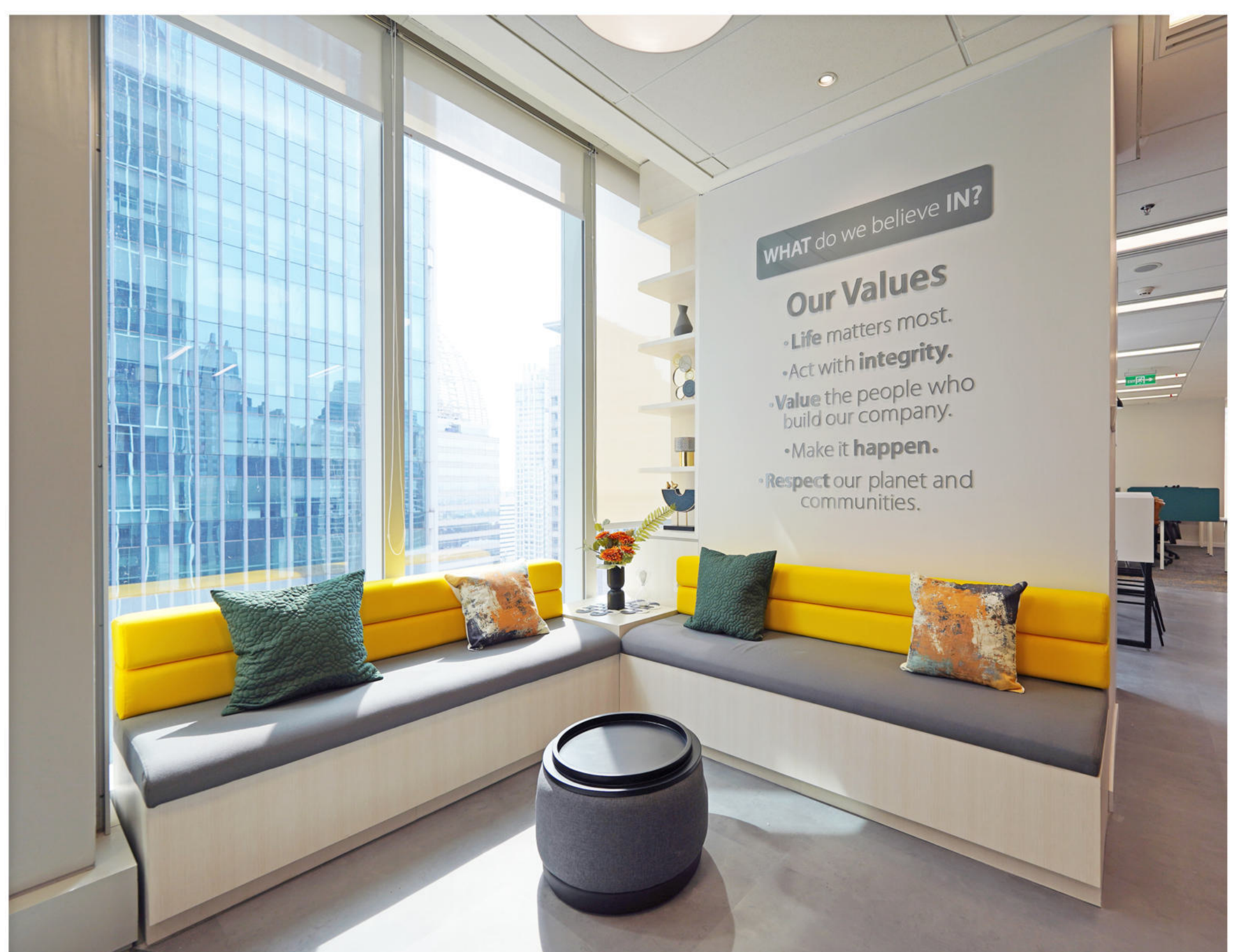
The design strictly adheres to Vale International standard guidelines, including shape, proportion, and color specifications, ensuring **consistency with global brand identity**.

Brightly colored pods and booths provide semi-private area for focus or small group collaboration.

Conference rooms combine neutral tones with accent walls for balance of professionalism and creativity.

Pantry and cafe zones with playful ceiling elements bring energy and encouraging **informal interactions and creativity**. Lounge corners with vibrant cushions and natural light act as relaxation hubs and informal discussion areas.

Wahana Office embraces the concept of the **"GROWING PATHWAY"**, a journey that symbolizes progress, direction, and continuous development. Taking inspiration from **Jakarta's urban dynamism and the road networks around Jakarta City**. The design reflects both the speed of movement and the idea of growth through pathways. The combination of **black, red and industrial grey** emphasizes strength and energy, while bold graphics bring movement into the space. A dramatic feature wall-angled LED strips conveys speed, direction, and modernity.

A collaboration area with tiered seating made from OSB wood provides flexible spaces for presentations, training, and group learning. The pantry and casual seating zones are dynamic and social, reinforcing community and creativity within the workplace.

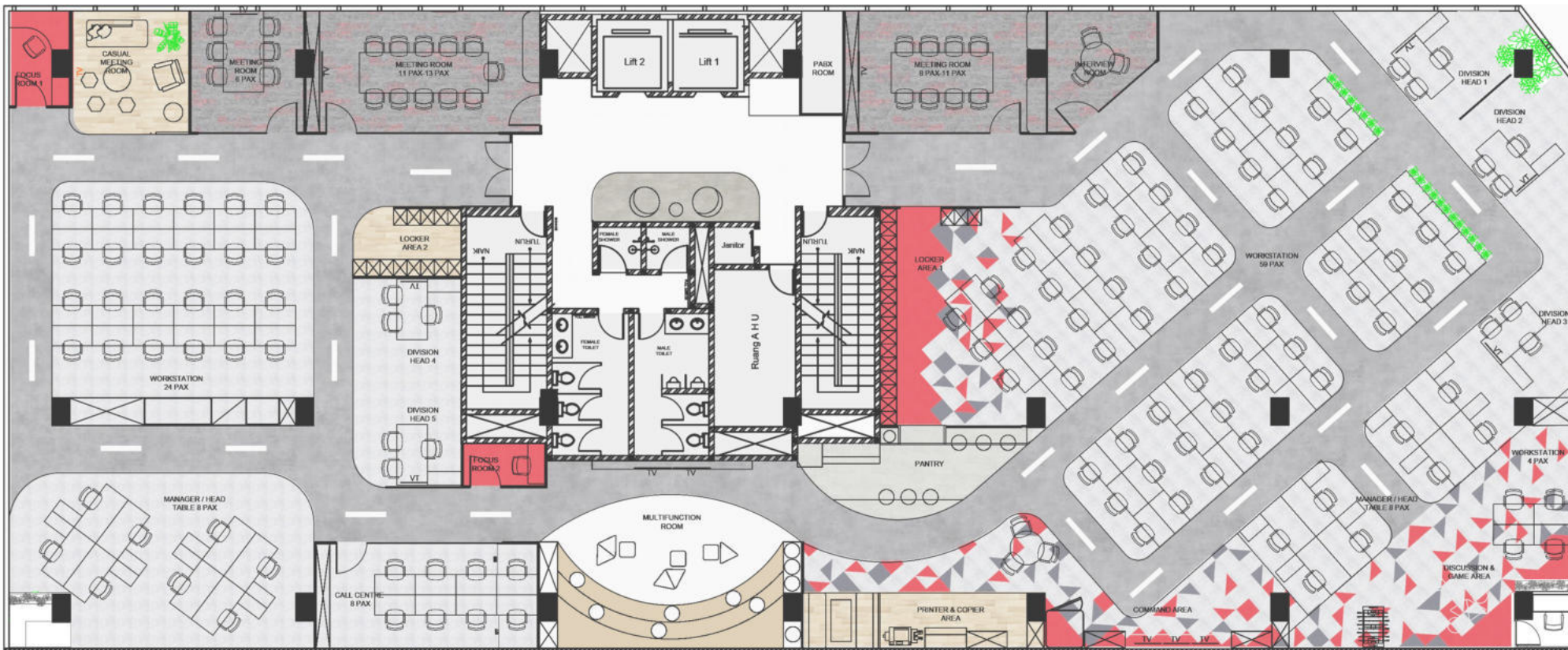




WAHANA PROJECT JAKARTA

The Wahana Office is not just a workplace. It is a **journey of growth and direction**. By weaving together the imagery of **roads, pathways, and Jakarta's local identity**, the design creates an environment that inspires employees to move forward, innovate, and take pride in their collective journey of continuous improvement.

The open office is organized around a **central "pathway" design** that visually guides movement across the workspace. This pathway acts as both circulation and metaphor - reminding employees of the company's continuous growth and clear direction. Workspaces are arranged along this axis, symbolizing collective progress. The result is an environment where employees feel part of a **shared journey** moving in unison toward growth and improvement.



The casual seating area acts as **rest stops along the pathway**, where employees can pause, recharge or collaborate informally. The furniture is flexible and playful, ranging from soft seating to high stools, arranged in clusters that encourage spontaneous conversations.

The meeting rooms are design as **strategic pit stops** along the company's growth journey. Glass partitions allow visibility and transparency while maintaining acoustic privacy, reinforcing openness in communication. The use of red accents energizes discussions, while industrial materials ground the space in strength and durability. These rooms become decision making hubs, where ideas align and new routes are mapped for the future.
