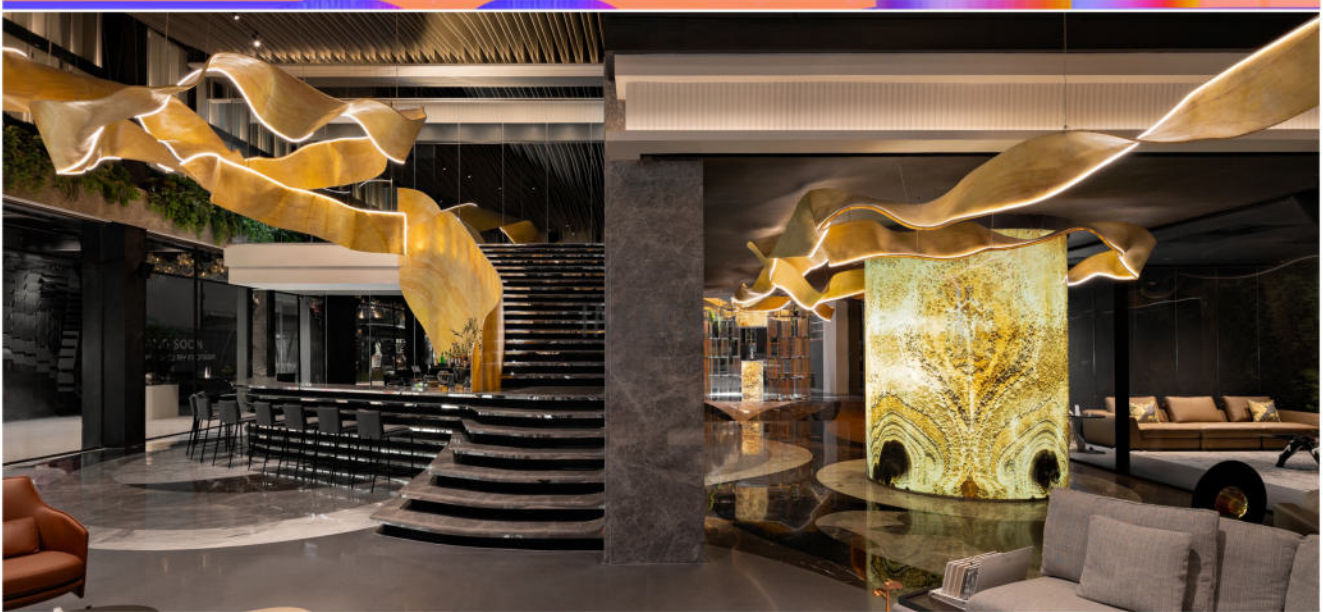

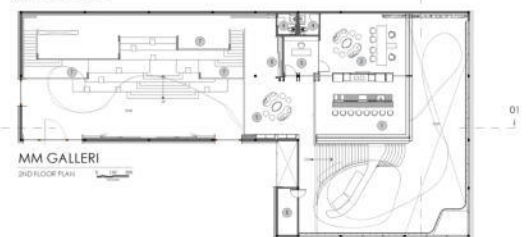

Each of these brands possesses unique strengths that set them apart in the industry. CNS carefully studied each brand's strengths to create an integrated, cohesive experience within a 999- square-meter area

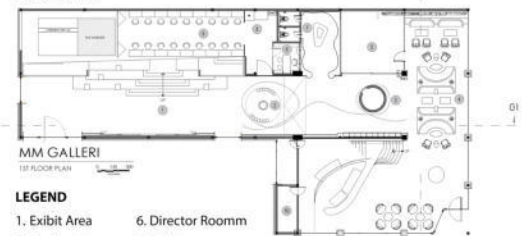
With MM Galleri's technology, a designer's vision can truly come to life. In this showroom, the designer designed the world's longest curved marble piece, showcasing the limitless potential for architects and designers. IL Sogno's expertise contributes with their impressive, oversized doors; Byo Living's intricate synthetic rattan weaving serves as an artistic sunshade; Lixil brings premium, diverse sanitary products; and the sintered stone experts—Agglotech, Dekton, and Lapitec—add their own distinctive touches. Homelogy rounds out the space with exquisite furniture design and high-quality finishes.

The layout is designed for seamless flow, with dedicated areas for various functions. Visitors enter directly from the Rasuna Lobby, greeted by an amphitheater that serves as a multifunctional space for coworking, product launches, seminars, and even fashion shows. This area is equipped with advanced multimedia capabilities, including a high-resolution projector, sound system, and adaptable lighting to suit diverse events.

2nd Floor Plan

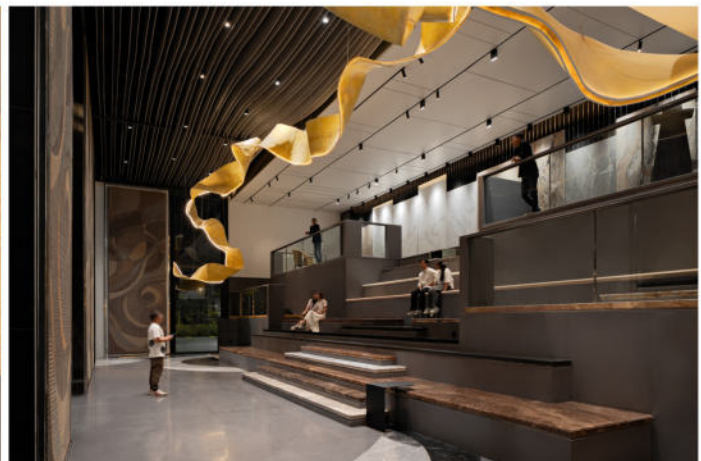


1st Floor Plan

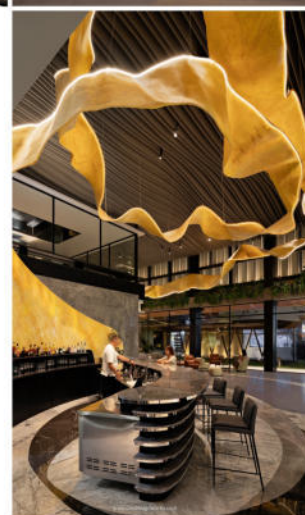

Above the amphitheater lies an exclusive display space for premium stone slabs, elevated by a hidden marble lift that introduces a dynamic new way to present marble beyond the traditional panel display.

A smooth transition through a corridor leads to two stunning island centerpieces crafted from onyx cylinders. The restroom, designed with a monumental marble cove concept, features a central fountain and dramatic cubicle designs that highlight marble as artwork, complemented by premium sanitary fixtures. At the end of the corridor, a VIP cigar room provides an intimate setting for exclusive guests.

The journey continues with varied ambiances along the corridor, creating a contrast in experiences. The curved marble element extends from the amphitheater to the lounge, making the space even more iconic. CNS focused on creating an experience that embodies the synergy of MM Galleri and each partner brand, delivering a space that redefines the possibilities for design and architecture in Indonesia.





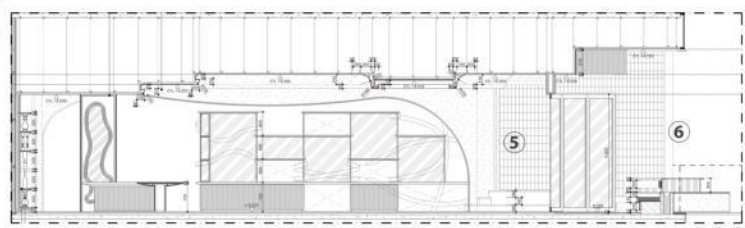
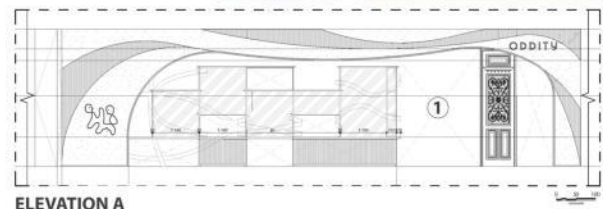
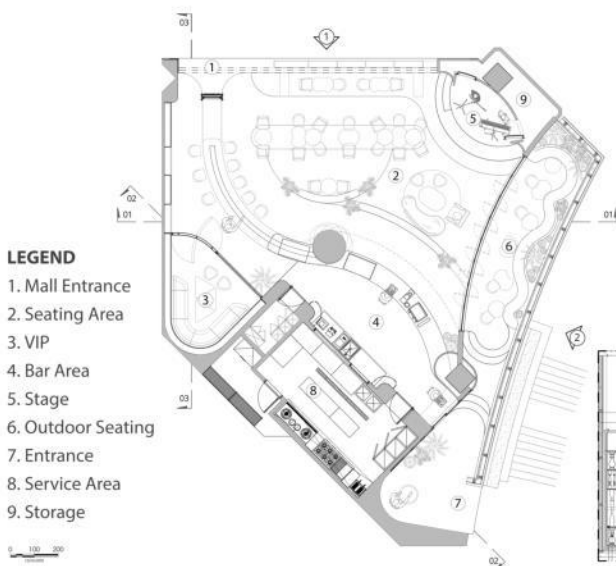
Where Odd Comes Alive

Oddity Coffee - Taman Anggrek Mall

Oddity Coffee is not merely a coffee shop, but a design statement that celebrates warmth through uniqueness. Inspired by the word odd—meaning unusual—this project gives life to a communal space that feels organic, welcoming, and full of surprises. Located in Taman Anggrek Mall, West Jakarta, the 263 m² café was designed in 2024 and completed in December of the same year.

Throughout its process, Oddity Coffee collaborated with renowned material brands, including Niro Granite, Artesa, Singres Mosaic, Matsuo, Asia Tiles, Dulux, Roxy Glass, Addstone, Forta, Kertasive, Sinergi Internusa Abadi, Tiffani Casa Moda, Every Collections, Taco HPL and Svarna Design. These partnerships enriched the spatial materiality, balancing natural textures, warm tones, and modern detailing.

The café's façade showcases organic forms clad in frosted glass—hinting at silhouettes of activity inside and sparking curiosity from passersby. There's a magical door that welcomes guests at the entrance, inviting them to step into a transition—from the bustling mall into an atmosphere that feels more intimate and engaging. Inside, visitors are greeted by a spatial flow that emphasizes natural circulation. Seating areas feature organically shaped tables—free from rigid geometry yet flexible enough to combine into communal formations. This philosophy of communal living forms the heart of Oddity Coffee: a place to share moments together with your family and friends.



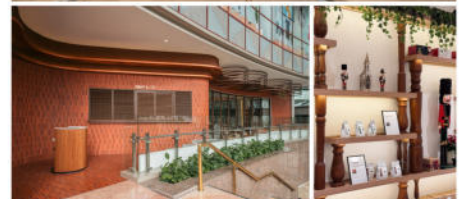
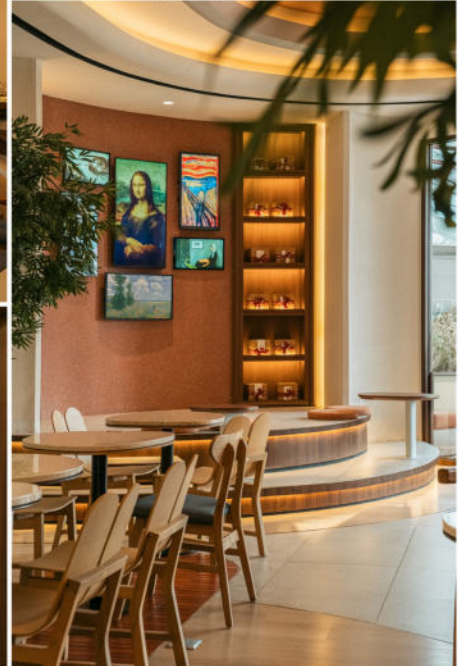
LAYOUT PLAN

At the center, an organically curved bar acts as the main anchor. Its fluid form guides movement while creating a slow bar experience that feels personal. Here, interactions between baristas and guests—choosing pastries, preparing beverages, engaging in light conversations—become an integral part of the narrative. Behind the bar, a display rack extends from the entrance to the rear, inspired by classic home railings but reinterpreted with unusual proportions—giving a touch of “oddness” that enhances the design’s charm.

In one corner, a small stage doubles as a multifunctional feature: on regular days it serves as additional seating, but it easily transforms into a space for workshops, music performances, or community events. The café also integrates a gallery-like presence through moving digital artworks—dynamic displays that add a contemporary dimension to the overall ambiance.

The journey continues into the outdoor area, which evokes the feel of a cozy home terrace—green, warm, and family-friendly. It also offers a grab-and-go access point, allowing guests to quickly pick up their orders without entering the main café.

Zoning is expressed through patterned flooring and expressive ceiling treatments. Terracotta finishes, dark wood, natural textures, and curved elements reinforce a homely yet modern aesthetic. All design choices are rooted in the project’s core principles: organic, curvy, odd, playful, and communal.

Ultimately, Oddity Coffee at Taman Anggrek is not just a café, but a gentle escape—where design flows with the pulse of the city, yet lingers with warmth like home. Every space carries a rhythm of togetherness, unfolding in curious, odd details that spark wonder. Here, the ordinary turns extraordinary, and “The Home of Oddities” becomes a home where comfort meets curiosity, and the odd becomes extraordinary.
