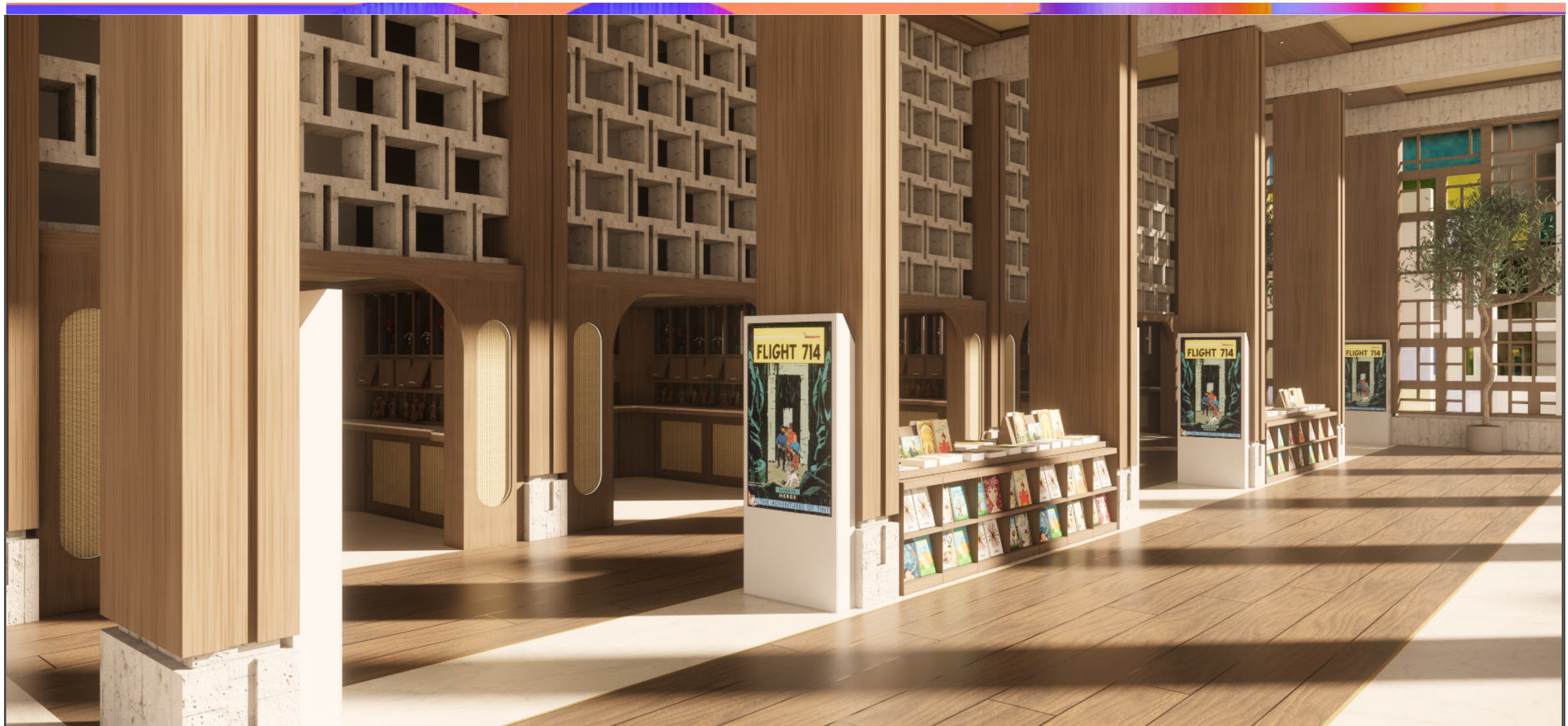




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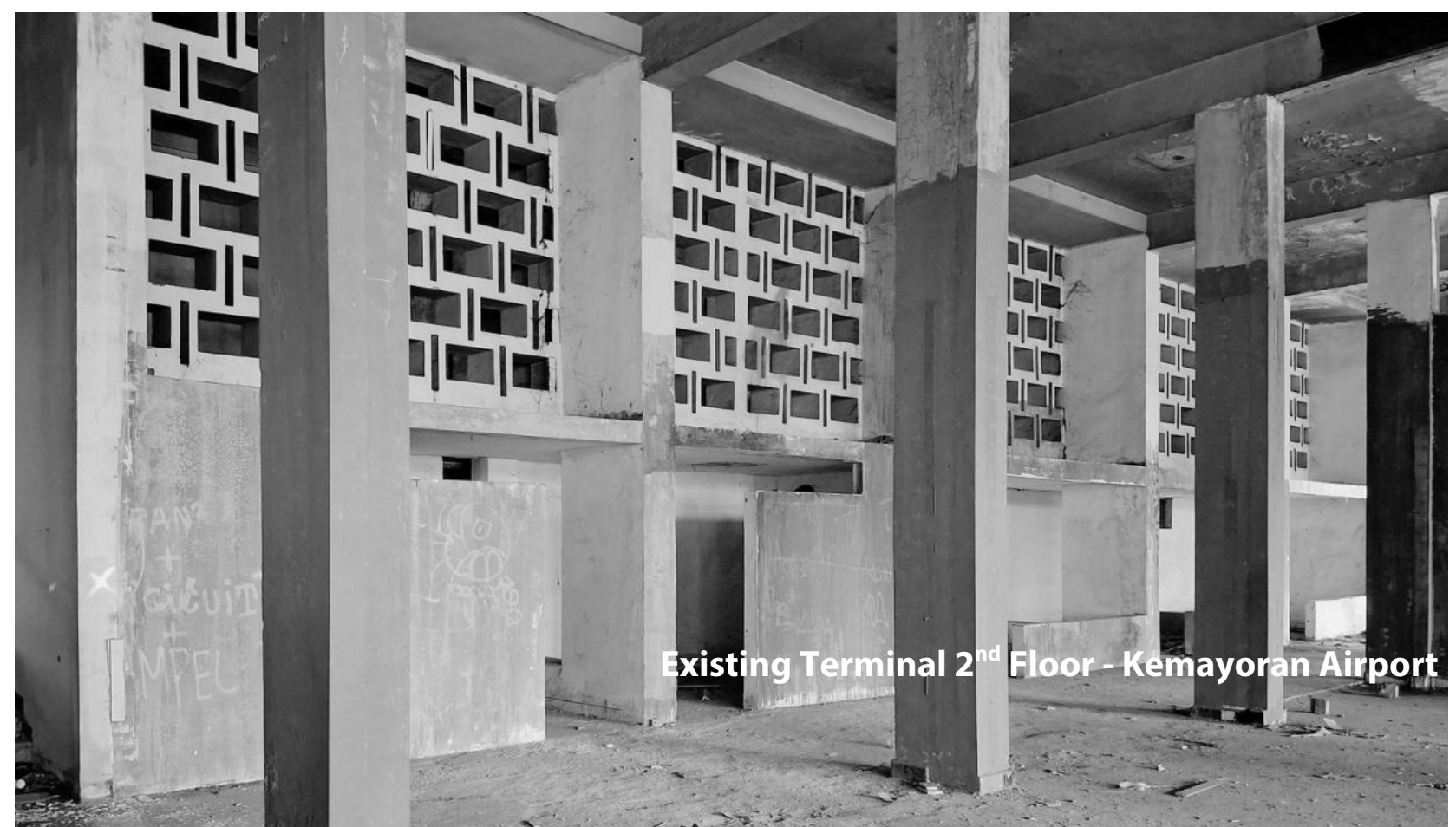
AEROSPACE GIFT SHOP

Existing Terminal 2nd Floor - Kemayoran Airport



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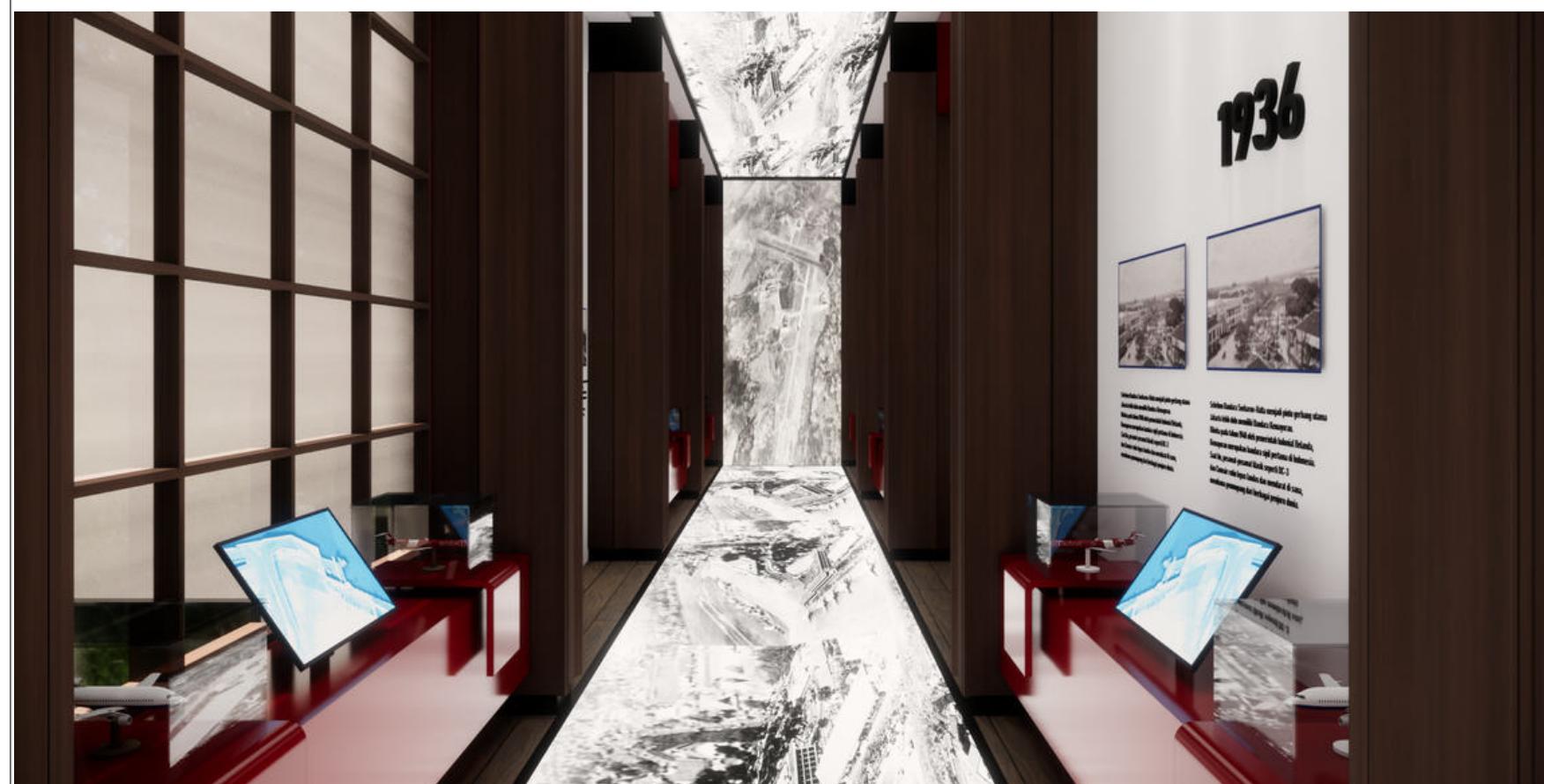




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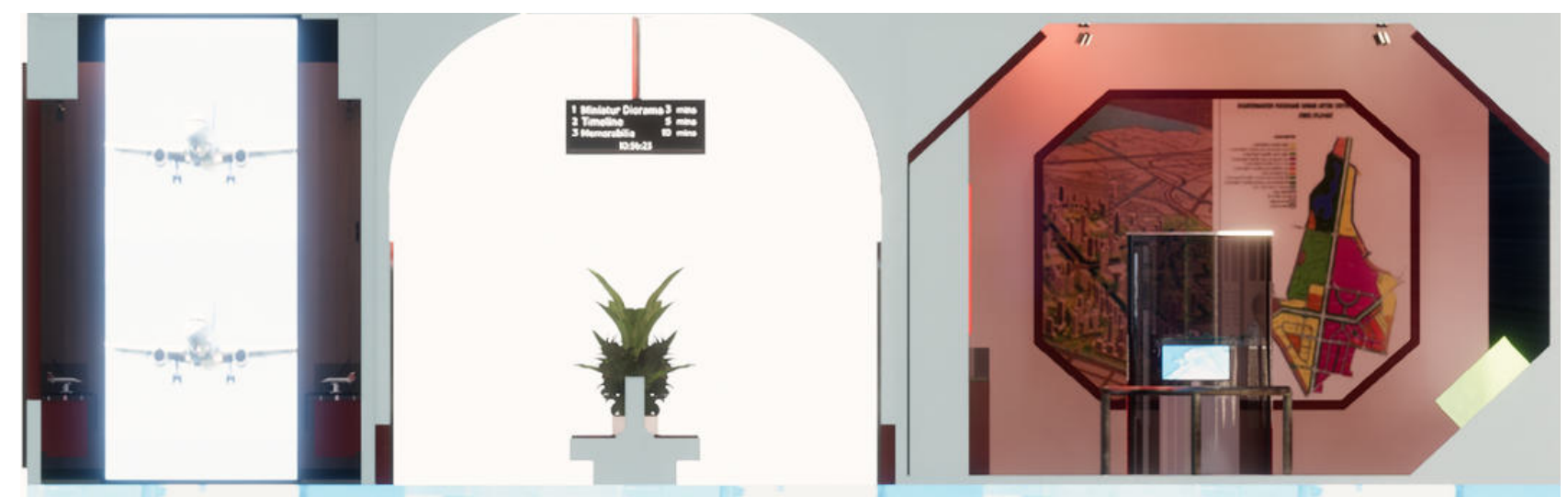
AEROSPACE TIMELINE

Aerospace timeline occupies the first floor at the center of the building, making it a symbolic heart of the exhibition. The "Timeline" concept unfolds the history of Kemayoran Airport, beginning with its construction during the Dutch East Indies era, moving through the independence period under President Sukarno's Old Order, into the New Order under President Suharto, and finally toward the airport's decline and closure. Each era is presented as a chapter in a journey, linking the airport's past to the broader narrative of the city.

Upon entering, visitors are immersed in the sensation of boarding an aircraft, with curved design elements creating an aerodynamic and futuristic atmosphere. A large airplane model at the center anchors the space, serving as both a visual focal point and a symbol of flight and progress. The timeline itself is arranged like a flight path, guiding visitors step by step through the milestones of Kemayoran's evolution. This sequence blends storytelling and exploration, making history feel active and alive.

Through its flowing layout and dynamic design, the space transforms historical material into a vivid experience. Rather than presenting the past as static, it invites visitors to reflect emotionally as well as visually turning the story of Kemayoran into a journey of discovery and inspiration.



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
