Kemayoran Airport, once Jakarta's international gateway and host to many historic events, now finds new life through adaptive reuse. The former VIP Lounge, an exclusive space for dignitaries, has been transformed into a creative hub that honors memory while fostering innovation.

Once an exclusive lounge for honored guests at Kemayoran Airport, this two-story space has been reimagined as a library at the heart of a new creative hub. The airport's original reliefs remain in clear view, with low bookshelves designed to showcase them rather than compete. Postmodern geometric shelving meets the soft curves of organic furniture, creating a dialogue between past and present. More than just a place for books, the library anchors surrounding galleries, research areas, and community spaces, turning Kemayoran's legacy of flight into a living archive of knowledge and culture.

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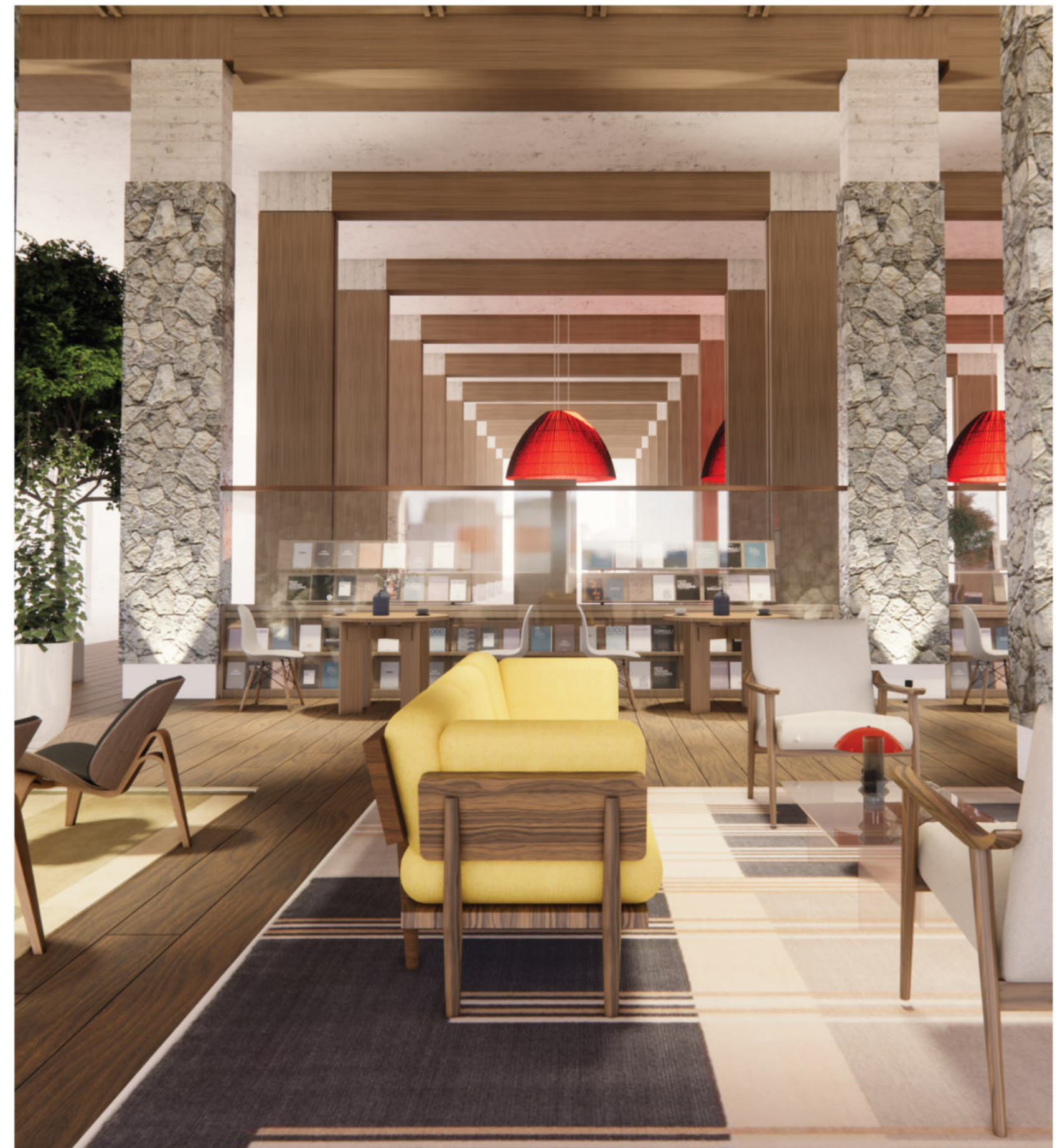

This coffee shop is designed as a welcoming space for visitors of the creative hub targeting young professionals, researchers, students, and the local community who seek both a relaxed atmosphere and a sense of exclusivity. Positioned in front of the restaurant within the former Kemayoran Airport complex, it unifies the F&B zone, making it a natural meeting point for casual hangouts, pre-meal gatherings, or breaks between programs.

The seating area is bright and cheerful, with colorful lounge chairs and sofas that make the space feel inviting without losing its sense of style. Dark wood flooring keeps the atmosphere warm and grounded. In contrast, the counter and pantry are designed with a modern industrial touch stainless steel, terrazzo, glass blocks, and exposed concrete clearly separating the service zone from the lounge while still keeping everything connected.



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
