Designing for Two Minds, One Space

A project that brings together two research groups from the University of Indonesia's Faculty of Psychology: the Traffic Research Group and the Lifespan Research Group. Each has distinct needs, but they share the same challenge: a small space where everyone needs to work comfortably and efficiently.

Different Needs, Same Challenge

The room assigned to both groups was relatively compact for the number of people using it, and only one side had windows. The challenge was clear: create enough space for individual work areas, meeting zones, and specialized functions, all within tight constraints.



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First Comes the Light

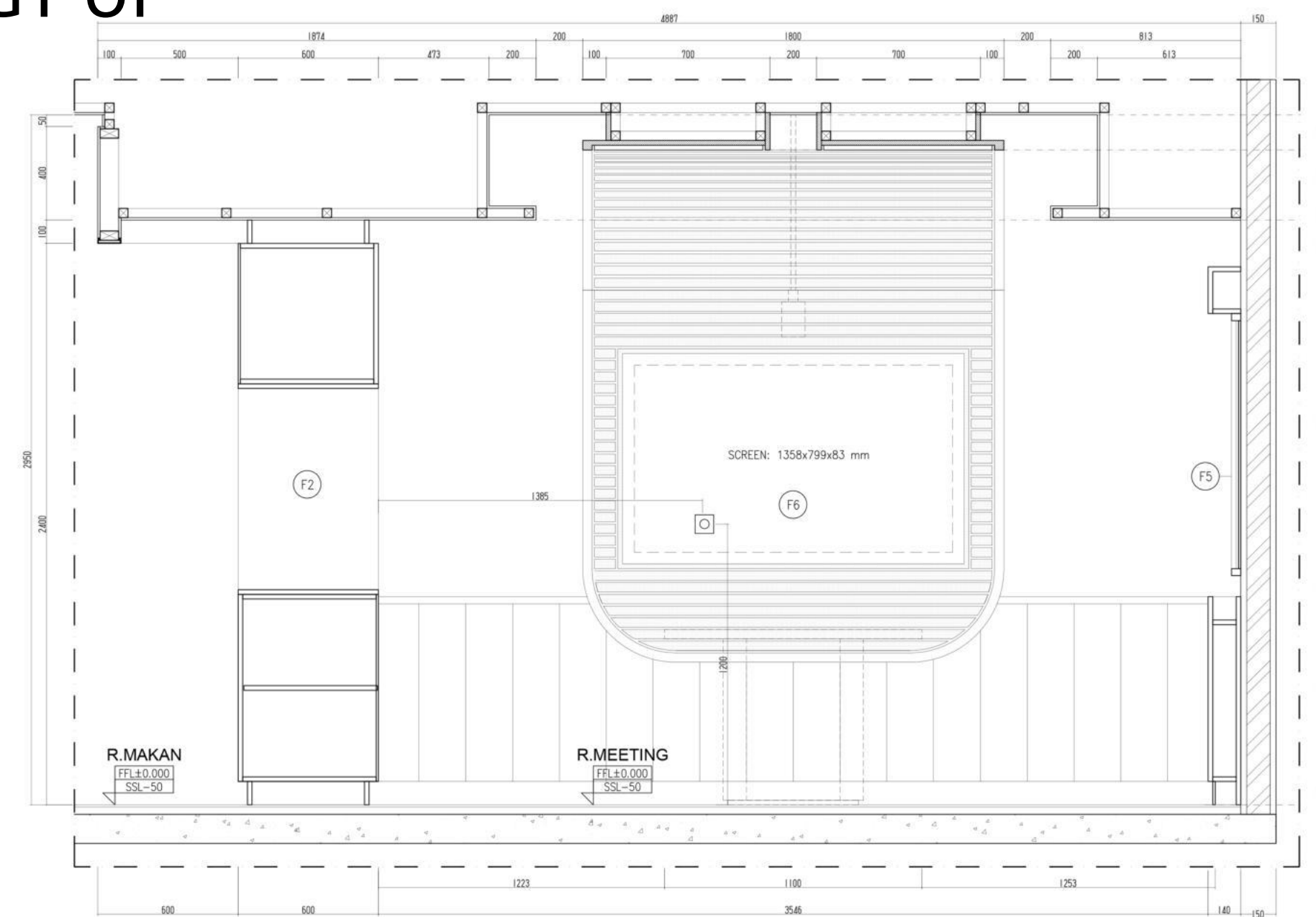
Our first design move was to make the window the focal point of the layout. We believed everyone should have access to natural light whether seated at their desks, walking through the space, or making coffee. The goal was a workspace that feels good wherever you are.

We added soft curves and gentle swirls not just for aesthetics, but to reduce visual blocks and help the space feel more seamless and breathable.

The Issue of Privacy

These researchers often deal with sensitive topics, so acoustic privacy was non-negotiable. But full soundproofing with thick walls wasn't always possible in such a tight space.

So we improvised: we redistributed some personal storage into shared walls. The added bulk helped with sound insulation, while freeing up personal space.

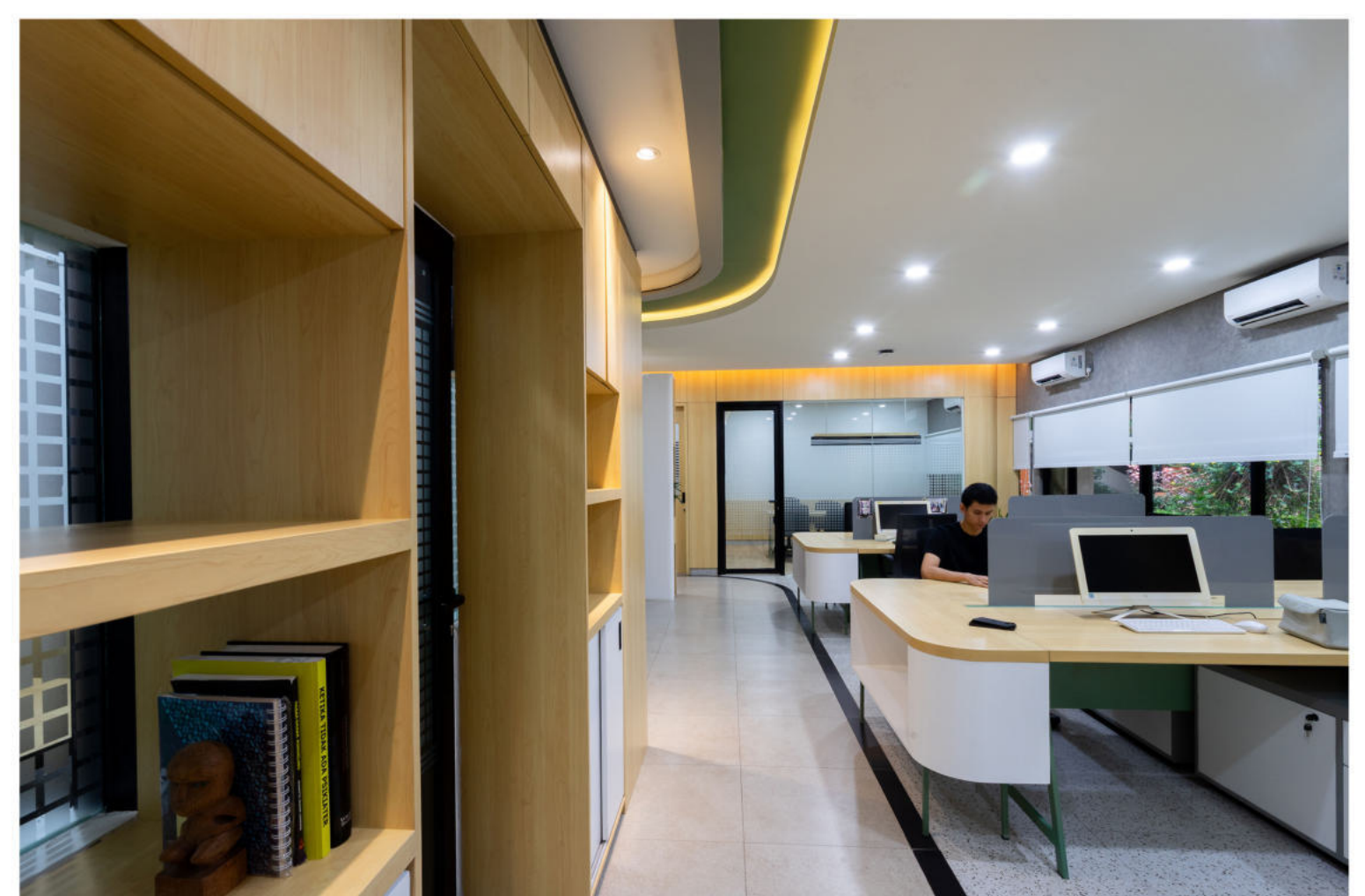
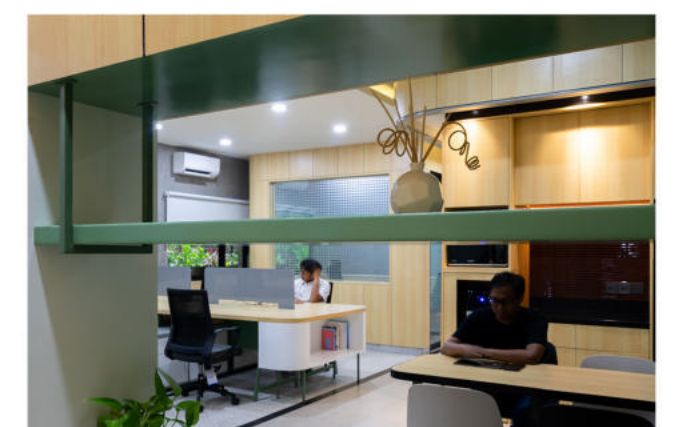
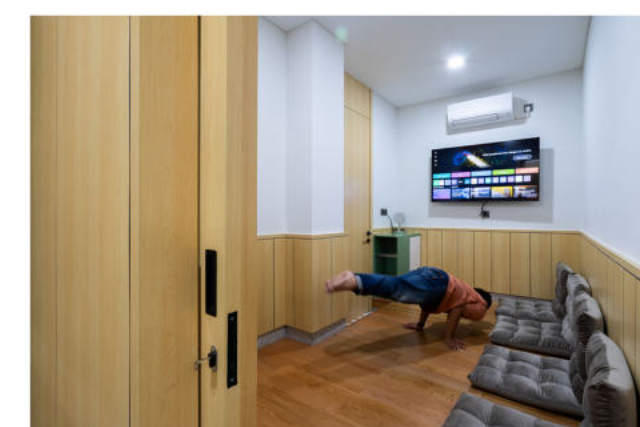
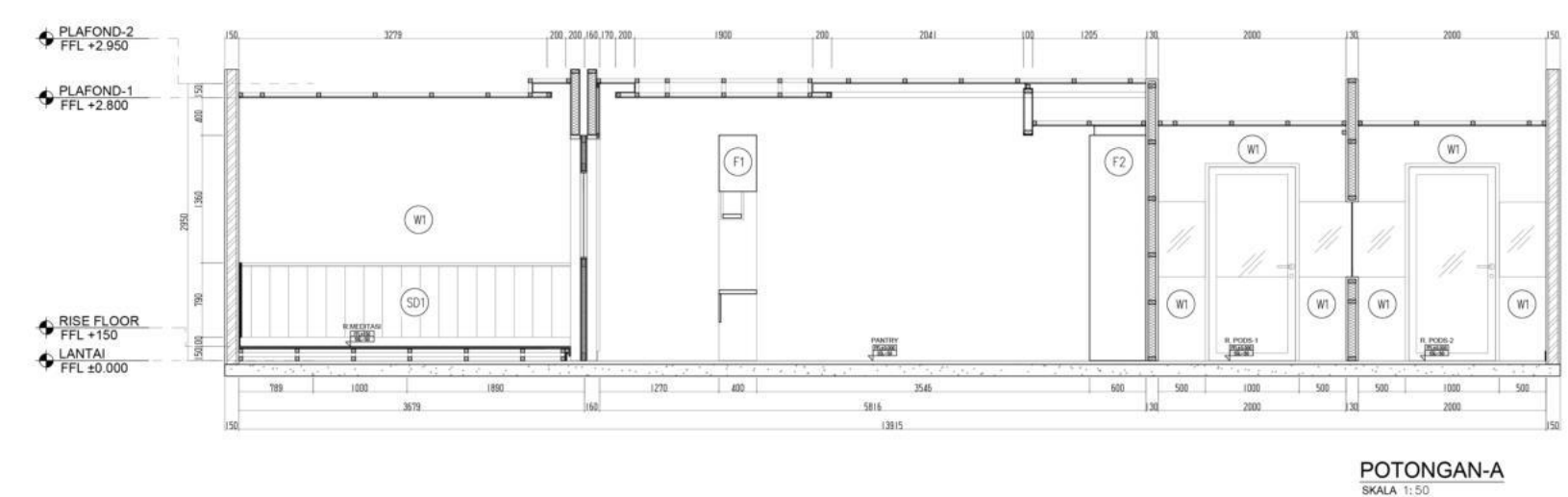
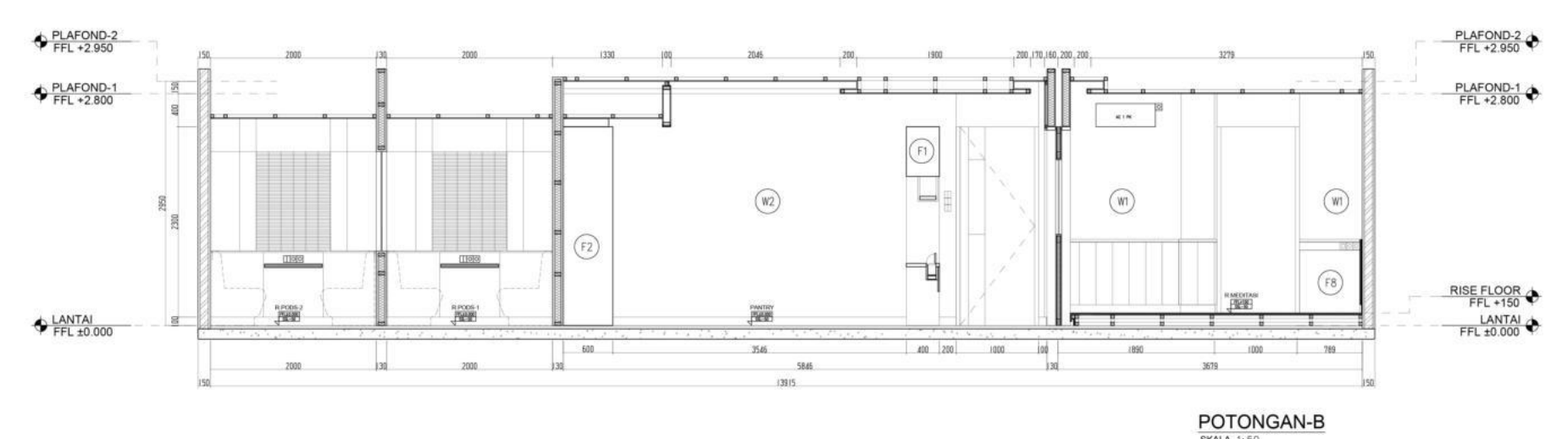
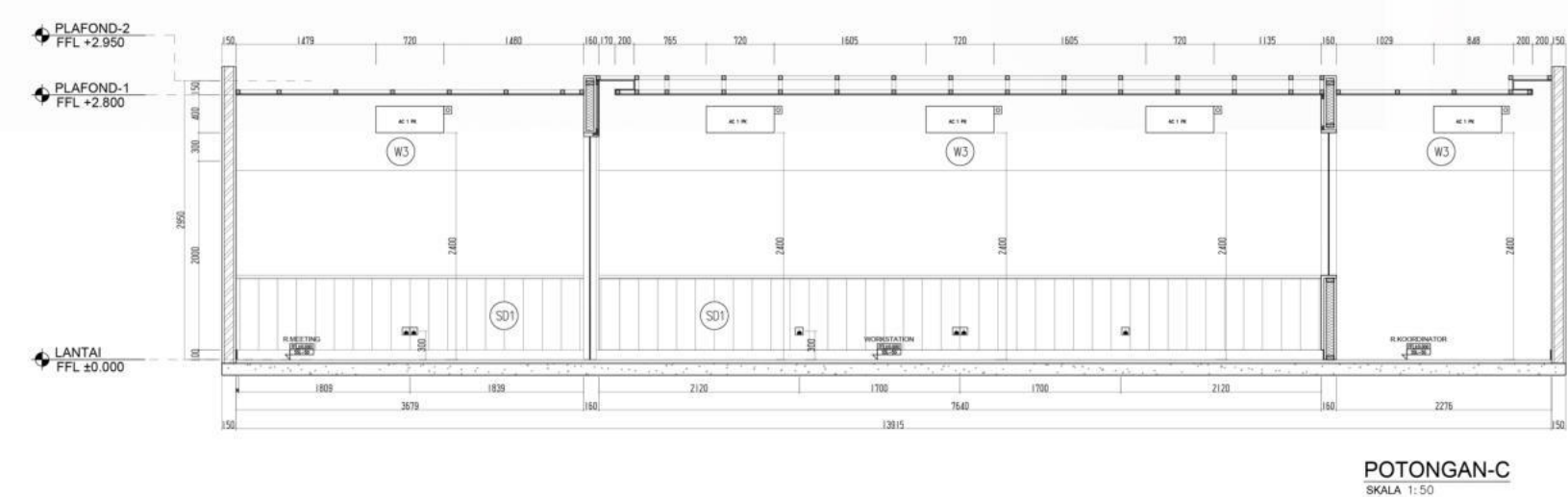
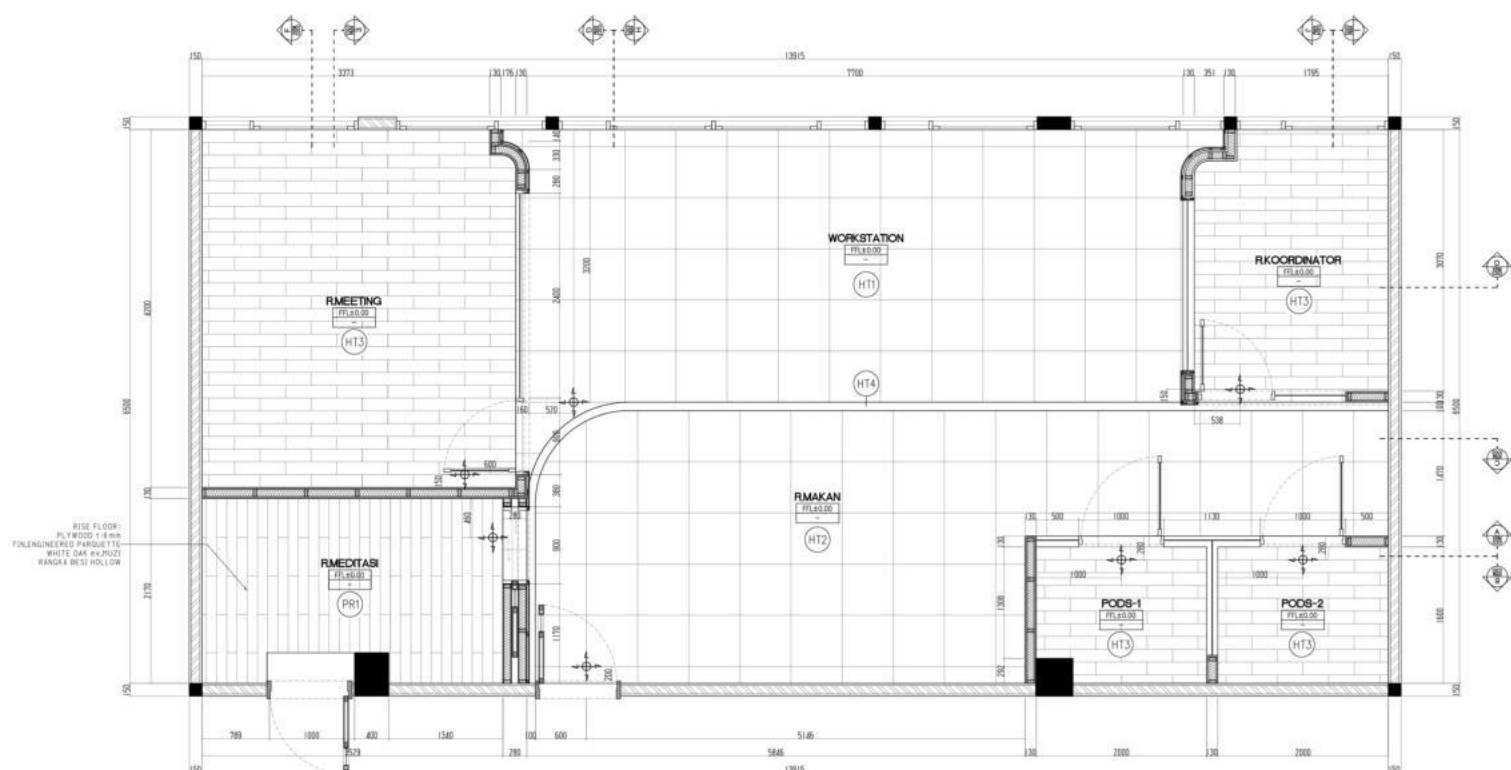
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Design for a peace of mind.

We were tasked with designing a working space for the Mindfulness Research Group of the Faculty of Psychology, University of Indonesia. The challenge was to accommodate a wide array of function in a tight space.

The Natural Light trick

No matter how clever we cram in these function to fit this small space, the inhabitants will feel crowded if they don't have access to natural light. That is why we made the only side with windows inclusive for all. Everybody gets a taste of sun every time, everywhere in the room. Unless they choose not to, there is a special area with no access to windows for meditation and self-reflection. This gives an airier sensation of the room.



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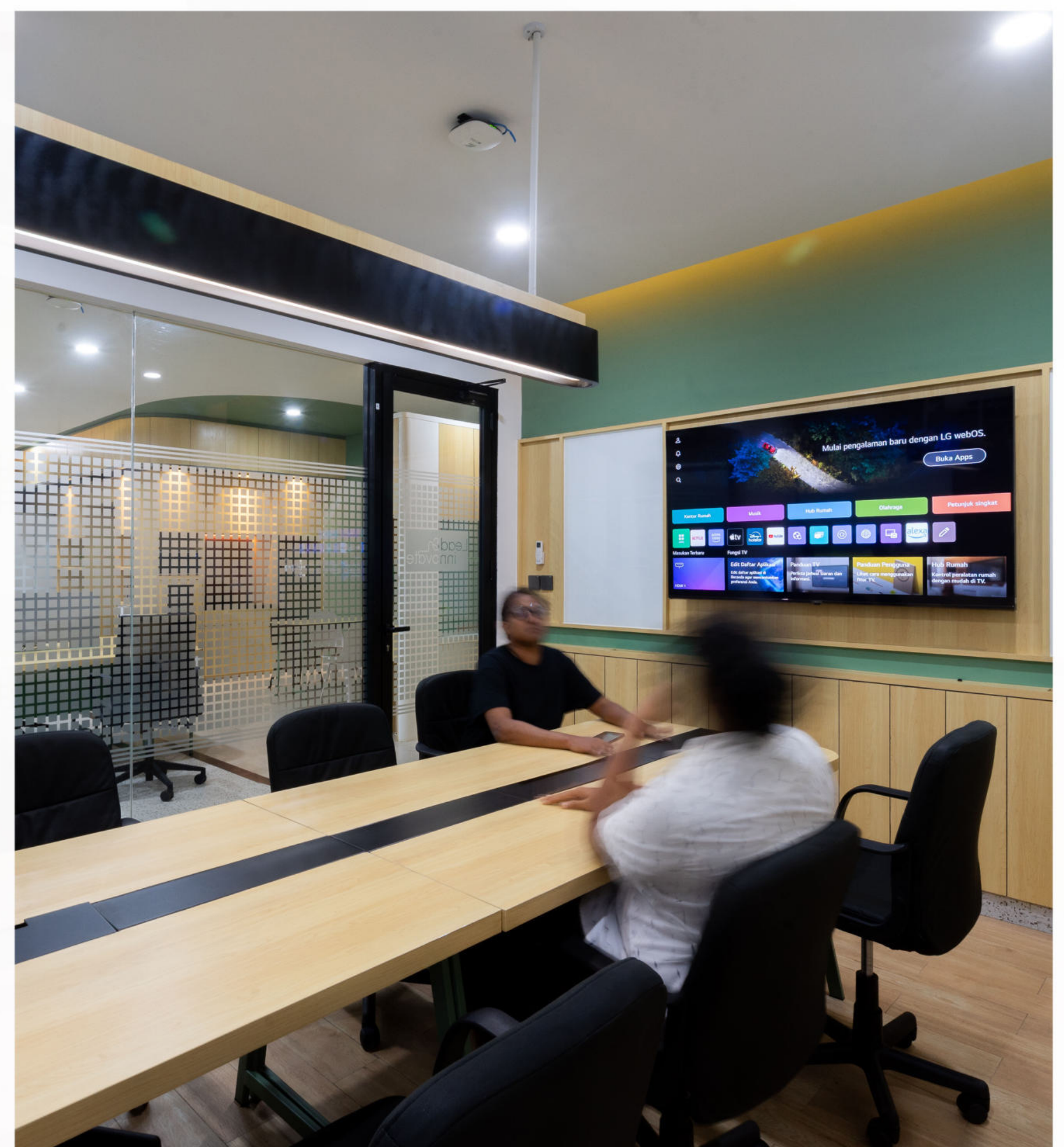
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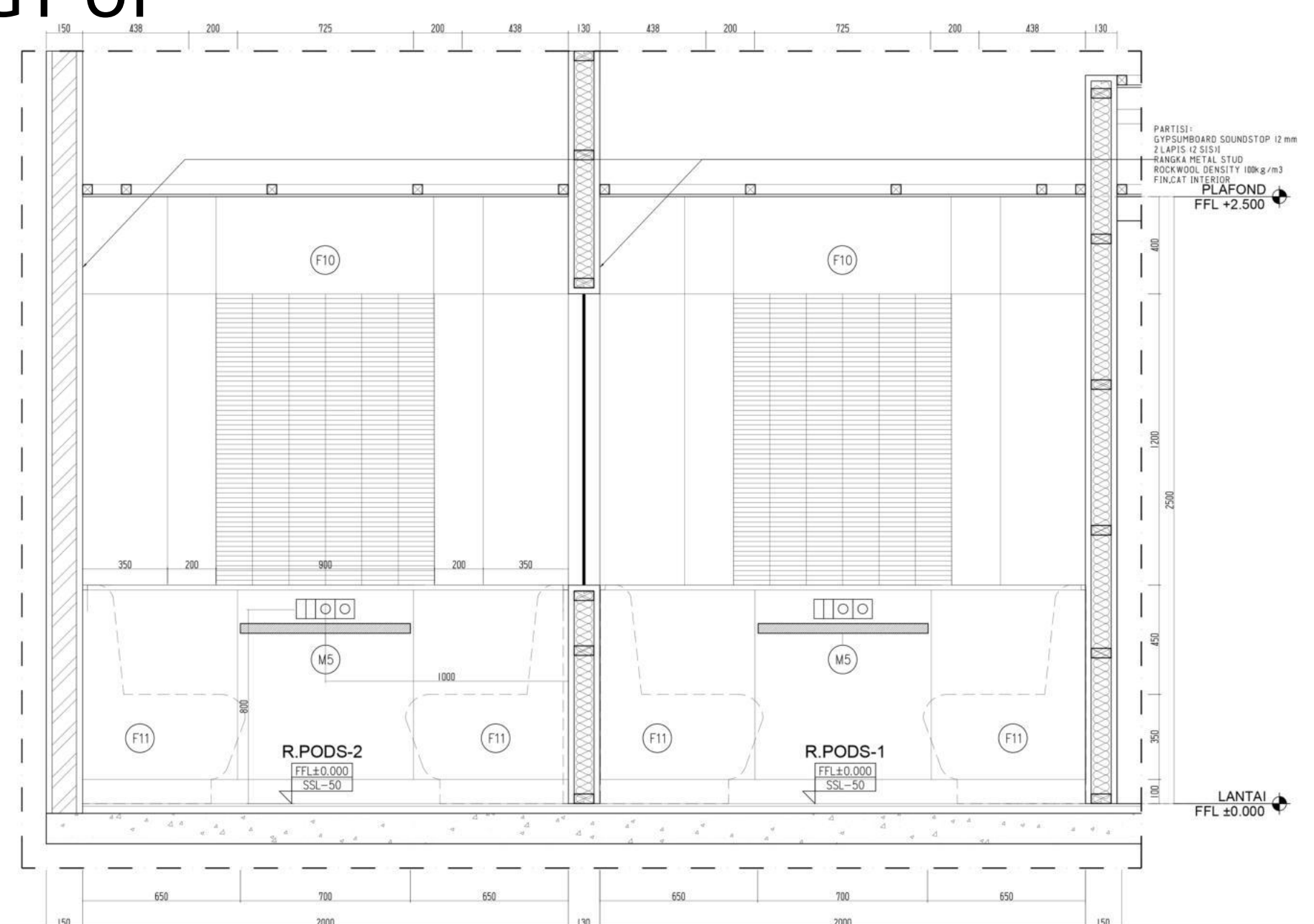
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Mindful of the space.

This working station is designed to house various activities: meetings, office desks, directors room, private pods, pantry, and a meditation space. Arranging these functions into one small space is managed by incorporating open plan office, and one main circulation weaving through all other functions. Giving the whole space an airier feel.

The meditating space

The research team involves many research subjects that are sometimes invited for an one-on-one interview session. The subjects may touch on personal or private matters. This calls the need for private pods. A soundproof, and private space. Of course, to keep the vibe of the space airy we choose glass for its walls. For a reflective meditative space, there is a meditation room, without the distraction of the outside world. A quiet and focused room with only a single screen in the room. A space to reinvigorate the mind.



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
