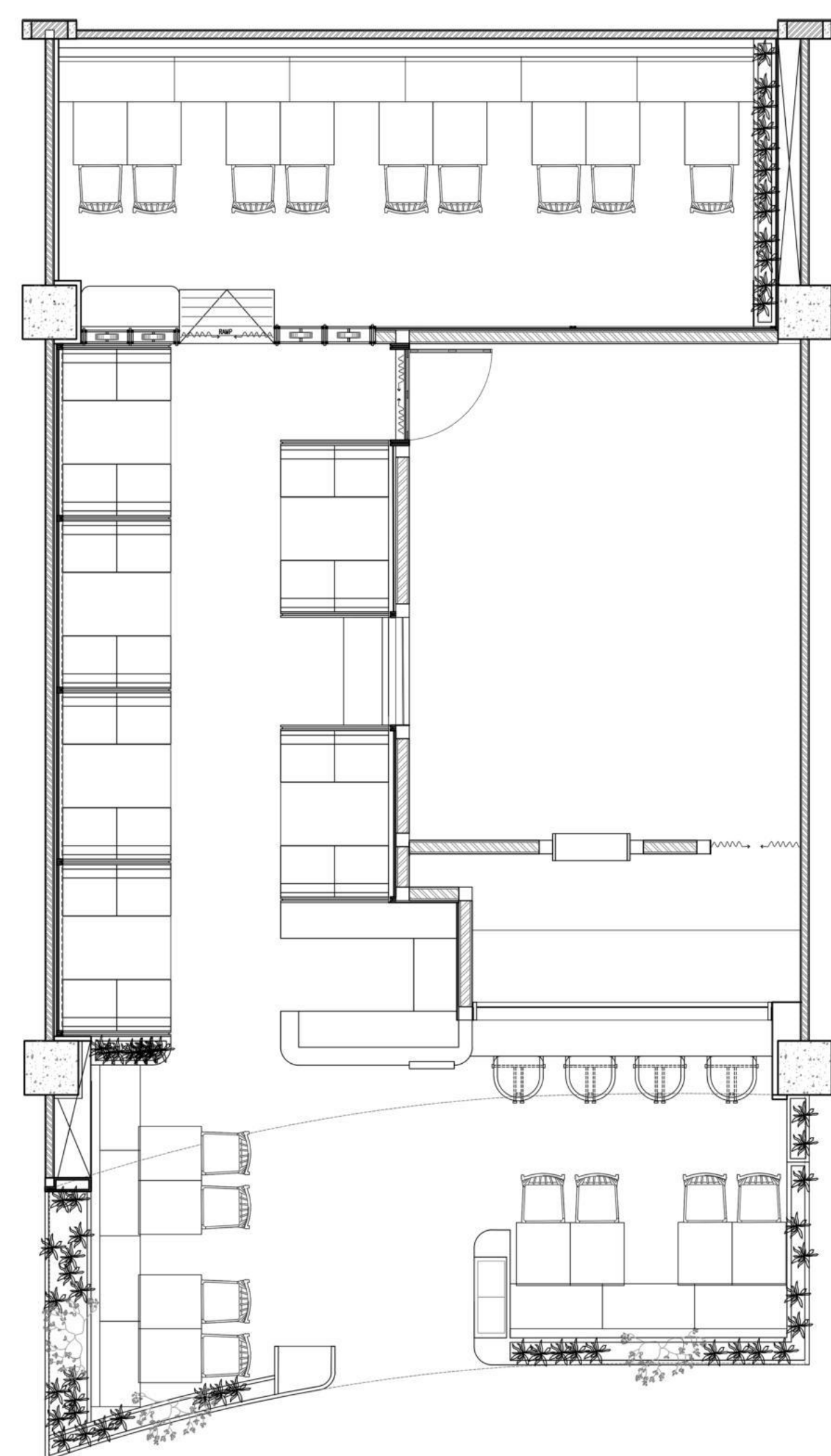




TAMI YAKITORI

The circular forms and wooden frames serve as a rhythmic divider while maintaining visual openness thus bridging culture, craft, and character in one immersive dining experience. A glowing acrylic ceiling inspired by traditional Japanese shoji screens softly illuminates the space, adding layers of culture and character.

At the heart of Tami Yakitori's facade, a yakitori grill window brings the sights, sounds, and aromas of live grilling to the forefront. Positioned right next to the cashier counter, this open feature turns the cooking process into part of the dining experience, inviting guests to connect with the craft and energy behind every skewer.

At the private dining area, subtle spatial illusion is added to elevate the dining experience. Full-height mirror panel at the end of the corridor reflects the patterned ceiling and icon-filled wall, doubling the visual depth and creating a sense of spaciousness within the compact layout.

A glowing acrylic ceiling inspired by traditional Japanese shoji screens softly illuminates the space, while a wall of circular lightboxes playfully displays Japanese icons of yakitori, sushi, and manekineko, adding layers of culture and character.
