

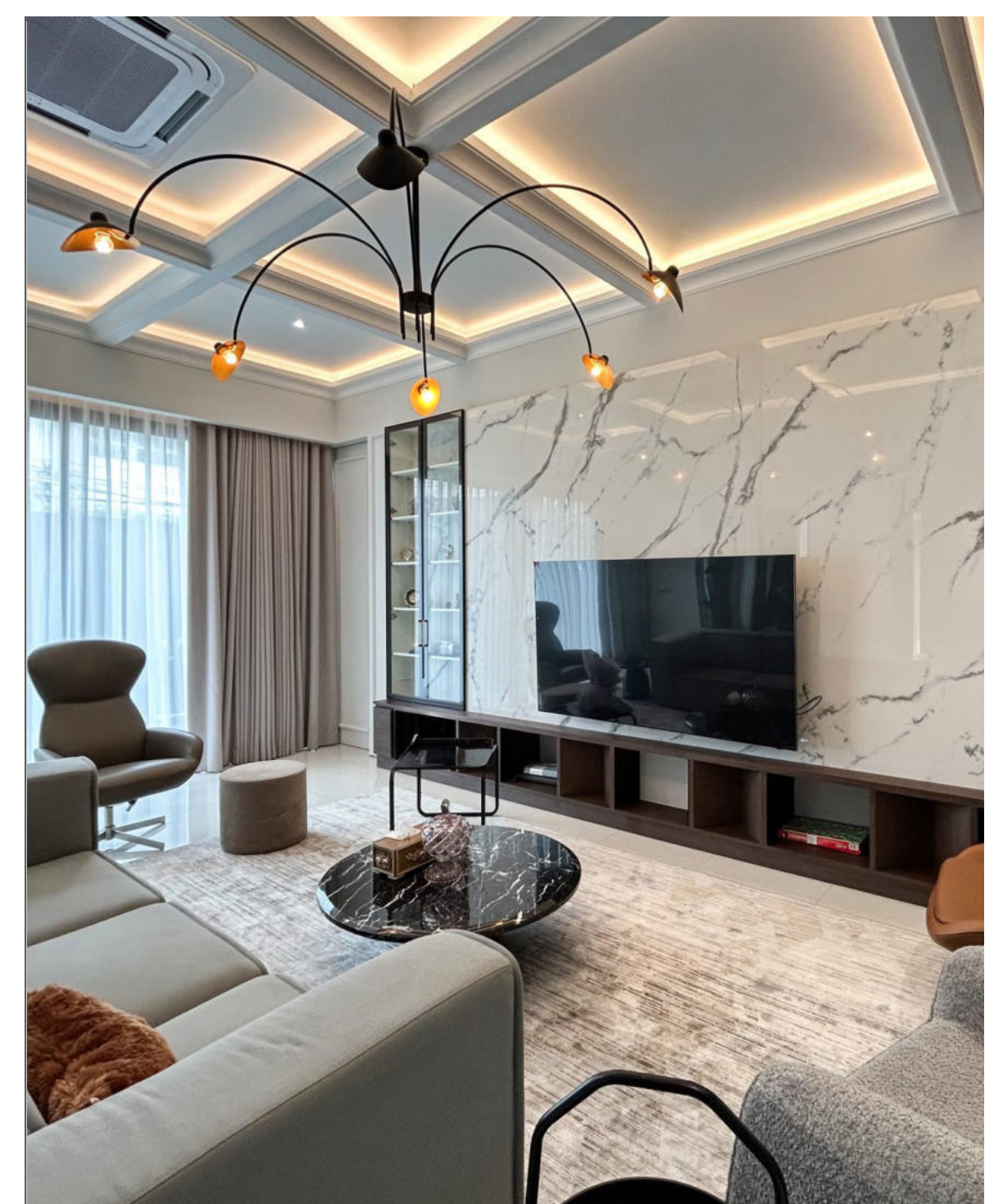


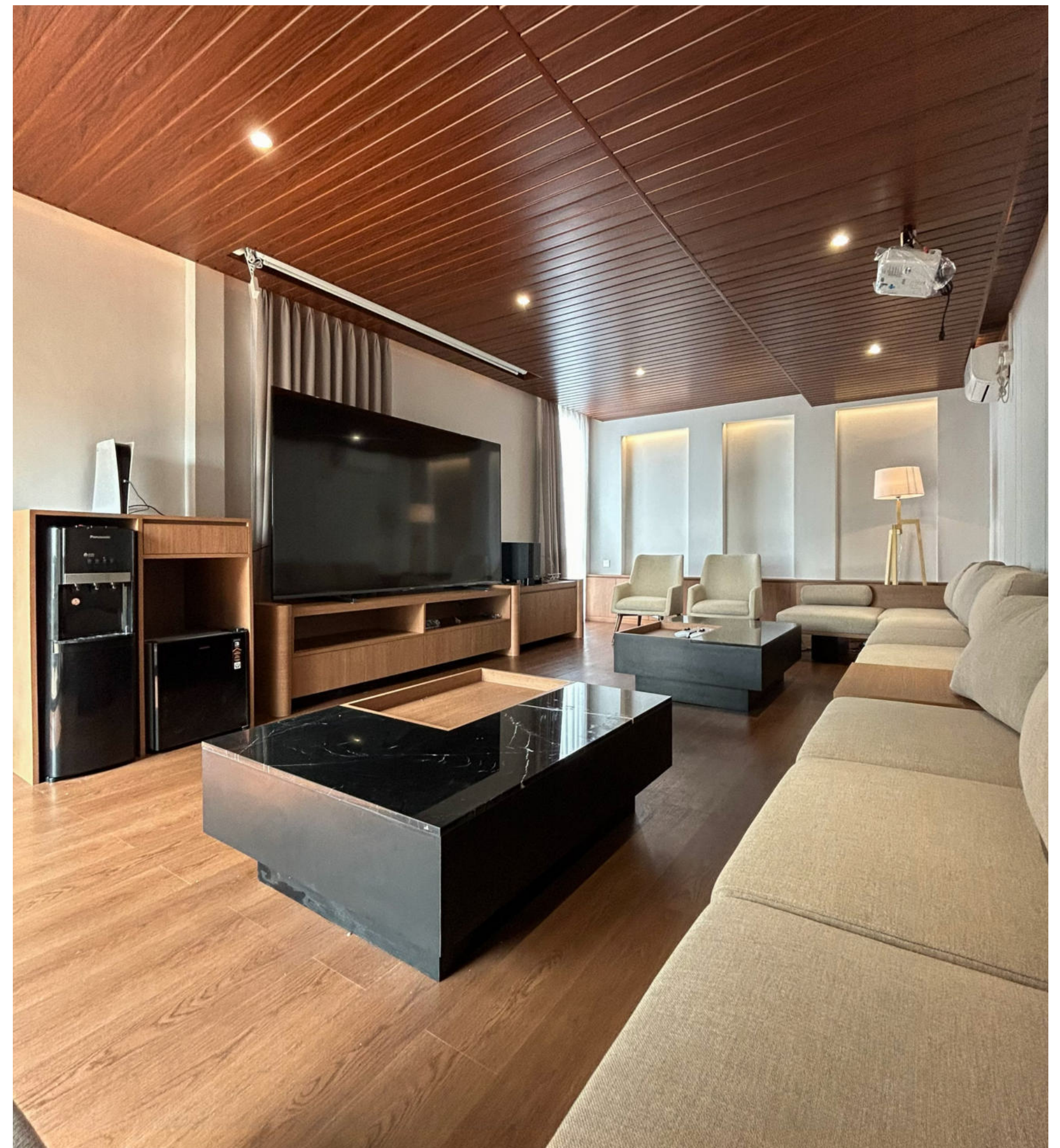
DR HOUSE

Positioned in the hoek of a busy four junction street, the owner desires a house with maximum privacy and comfort. We decided to design a courtyard house, not one courtyard, but two courtyards; one on ground level, the other on second floor connected to the rooftop. The aim is to get more access to the natural light while maintaining privacy from the street.

The interiors of DR House are guided by a modern monochromatic palette softened with medium to dark wood tones. Clean lines shape the visual rhythm across spaces, creating a contemporary mood that feels both sleek and grounded. Natural light filters through the dual courtyards, animating the interiors with shifting shadows and a constant dialogue with the outdoors.





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Each room reflects its occupant's personality while maintaining cohesion through consistent base colors and wood finishes. The children's bedrooms are playful variations, the master suite exudes calm restraint, and the rooftop lounge adopts a darker palette for intimacy and evening gatherings. The design seeks harmony between individuality and unity, privacy and openness making the house not just a shelter, but a living canvas of its family's character.
